Knauf Futurepanel is a first for the UK construction industry - a carbon neutral plasterboard. Plus at least 10% of its core is manufactured from gypsum that we have recycled. The remaining gypsum used comes from the most sustainable sources available to us and the liners are made from 100% recycled paper.

Knauf Futurepanel has the same performance as Knauf Wallboard, and is installed in the same way. By specifying Knauf Futurepanel you are helping to lower the carbon footprint of your projects and, in turn, safeguarding the future of our planet for future generations.

Knauf Futurepanel can be used in all areas where a standard Wallboard would be used, giving identical or better system performance. Being a 10kg/m² board Futurepanel is ideally suited for use in housing for Part E.

How are we making Futurepanel carbon neutral?

We are actively reducing energy usage throughout our production process and investing heavily in renewable fuel sources such as wind to remove carbon at source. Our plan is to continue to remove carbon at source wherever practical.

The remaining carbon created during production of Futurepanel is being offset through investment in specific projects that remove carbon at source by providing renewable energy resources for other communities. Examples of these projects include the building of hydro-electric power stations and biomass boilers. These projects will significantly reduce carbon at source, and will continue to do so into the future.

Our ongoing aim is to continue to find ways to remove carbon used during production, and to reduce the need to offset, but whatever the mix, we will ensure that Futurepanel continues to be totally carbon neutral.
